Subject: **LICENCE FOR LPG TRANSPORTATION THROUGH ROAD BOWSERS**

Dear Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. SAM/LPG/OGRA/21-064 dated March 8, 2021, on the above subject and to enclose herewith a licence granted by the Authority for transportation of LPG in respect of your Six (06) LPG Road Bowsers (list attached as Annexure-A) for a period of fifteen (15) years under Rule-7 of LPG Rules, 2001. The Company holds valid Explosives' Licences on Form "R" in respect of each bowser from the Department of Explosives under the MIGS Rules, 2010 and that the bowsers are manufactured as per the Department of Explosives' approved Standard i.e. ASME Section VIII (Div. I), which is the statutory Authority under the MIGS Rules, 2010 in the matter. The list of licensed bowsers (Annex-A) of your Company has also been uploaded at the OGRA's website (www.ogra.org.pk) for information.

2. In case, the Company intends to engage hired/ rented bowsers for transportation of LPG, it shall be ensured that the said bowsers hold valid Explosive Licences on Form-R granted by the Department of Explosives under the MIGS Rules, 2010. Moreover, the Bowsers shall also have the licences granted by OGRA for undertaking transportation of LPG and meet the applicable safety codes/ technical standards as laid down in the LPG Rules, 2001 and MIGS Rules, 2010 to avoid accidents and to ensure public safety.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LICENCE

The Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule-7 of the LPG Rules, 2001, is pleased to grant the above captioned licence to the addressee on the terms and conditions as stated herein: -

- i. The operations of the Licensee, stated hereinafter but not limited to the same, shall be governed at all times by the OGRA Ordinance 2002 (Ordinance XVII of 2002), Liquefied Petroleum Gas (Production and Distribution) Rules, 2001 and the rules concerning storage, filling, transportation, distribution and marketing of LPG promulgated pursuant to OGRA Ordinance, Petroleum Rules 1937, and all other applicable laws as amended from time to time, unless otherwise specified in this licence.
- ii. All safety measures for transportation and handling of LPG shall be taken by the Licensee in accordance with the standards set in the LPG (Production and Distribution) Rules, 2001 and Minerals and Industrial Gases (MIGs) Rules, 2010. The Licensee shall also strictly comply with the prescribed standards and codes as set out in Appendix-1 of the LPG Rules, 2001 or any other applicable rules, safety codes and technical standards.
- iii. All the other relevant codes / standards / policies / laws of the Federal / Provincial Governments shall be complied with whenever necessary / applicable.
- iv. The Authority may, from time to time, issue instructions / SOPs, which in the opinion of the Authority would be necessary for safe handling / transportation of LPG and/or to safeguard the public interest. All such Authority's notified SOPs, instructions and directions shall be binding on the licensee.
- v. The Licensee shall NOT undertake transportation of LPG through road browser(s) unless the same are covered by Comprehensive Third-Party Insurance against the loss and damage to the public life and property as defined in Rule 27(1) of LPG (Production and Distribution) Rules, 2001. The Licensee shall always ensure that it holds valid "Comprehensive Third-Party Insurance Certificate" for each listed browser.
- vi. The Licensee shall be responsible for any mishap that takes place during transportation of LPG due to incompetence, negligence or use of substandard material or equipment and shall be liable to compensate the loss of life and property, as determined by the Authority, on case to case basis, under Rule 27(2) of LPG Rules 2001. The penalty and/or compensation so fixed by the Authority shall be paid within a period of one month of the issuance of an order by the Authority.
- vii. The Licensee shall always timely provide the information / reports in the manner and frequency as may be required by the Authority from time to time.
- viii. In case any information/document or undertaking provided at any stage by the licensee is found to be incorrect, bogus or fake, the licence or permission granted on the basis of such information/document or undertaking shall be cancelled/revoked/withdrawn in addition to any other legal action, penalty which the OGRA is empowered to initiate/impose under the law.

- ix. The Licensee shall be liable to strict action under the applicable laws in case it is found to be involved in willful stoppage of LPG transportation activity or restrict the supply of product to marketing companies.
- x. There shall be Emergency Response Plan /Emergency Nos. for possible emergencies. Each Bowser shall be provided with at least one approved portable fire extinguisher having a minimum capacity of 18 lb (8.2 kg) dry chemical with a B:C rating. The driver and the helper shall be fully trained for using the fire extinguishers and to respond in accordance with Emergency Plan in an emergency. No person shall smoke or carry lighted smoking material on or within 25 feet of a LPG Bowser.
- xi. Each Bowser shall carry Chock Blocks, which shall be used to prevent rolling of the vehicle whenever it is being loaded or unloaded or is parked.
- xii. Bowser shall not be parked in congested area and shall not be left unattended on any street, highway or avenue except for necessary absence from the bowser, associated with driver normal duties, but that shall not apply in an emergency.
- xiii. The Licensee shall write conspicuously, the word "HIGHLY INFLAMMABLE" on the side and back of the storage tank in red color and maximum speed limit of the bowser shall be restricted to 25km/hr.
- xiv. The LPG Bowser shall be attended at all times by at least two persons fully conversant with its mechanism and handling of LPG in any emergency.
- xv. The Authority may conduct inspections, either itself or through its third-party inspectors, and shall take necessary action in case of any complaint or if any bowser is found not complying with the applicable standards / rules / codes. The Licensee shall pay to such third-party inspector or inspectors a reasonable fee, as determined by the Authority from time to time.
- xvi. In case of any accident, Licensee shall immediately, but not later than forty-eight hours of an accident, submit an initial report to the Authority indicating details of the accident and any remedial measures taken thereto.
- xvii. The list of Bowsers is enclosed as **Annexure-A**. In case of any amendment/change/ alteration in the licence/attached list, prior approval of the Authority shall be obtained under the Rules.
- xviii. Any change in the Chief Executive or Directors of the Company shall be reported to the Authority within fifteen (15) days of such a change.
- xix. **ACCEPTANCE:** Please convey your acceptance of the terms and conditions of this license within 15 days of its issuance after which it shall stand construed as acceptance of this licence and that the terms and conditions have been carefully read and understood by all managerial and operating staff of the licensee.
